2025 Tolls & Taxes

Ratepayers will notice that the 2025 Taxes will increase by 10%. Tolls cover such things as electricity to pump water, water samples, lab analysis, staff wages, repairs, regular maintenance, government mandated audits, invoicing, postage, and insurance. Tolls increases will be determined by the new board at the ratepayer's request.

Main Line Flushing

System flushing of the water lines and fire hydrants will occur *April 1-30*, *2025*. This is required so we can continue to maintain the supply of safe high-quality water. There should be no interruption of water supply. During a period of several days, there may be a taste and smell of chlorine in the water. The treated water will disinfect your water lines so the BFWD can ensure the freshest water possible.

Updates 2025

Invoicing for 2025 will be combines Tolls and Taxes on one invoice sent out on July 1, 2025. Due date for both is September 1, 2025 and applicable penalties will be applied for all late payments.

There will be several important discussions regarding the future plans of Beaver Falls Water Works District discussed at the AGM. If you want a voice in what happens to the water system, please try to attend. We will be engaging an engineer to complete a water management plan to get an accurate picture of our infrastructure and the districts capabilities going forward.

Call before you dig to prevent accidents. BC One Call's toll-free number 1-800-474-6886 to request a utility locate when planting trees or digging on your property. Do not take chances; some utilities can be less than 6" deep.

If you are connecting, disconnecting your waterline, or installing irrigation systems, you **MUST** advise the Beaver Falls Waterworks as we will ensure our Certified Water Operator is present. This is for the safety of your drinking water.

Water Quality

The district's drinking water comes from underground aquifers and is untreated. BFWD takes water samples from designated sites within the district and send them for regular testing of Total Coliform and E Coli. Any adverse results are reported directly by the laboratory to Interior Health as well as the BFWD. The testing results have shown that our water is good and within the requirements set out by the Canadian Drinking Water Quality Act.

Sprinkling Regulations (Bylaw No.192)

Spring is coming and the BFWD would like to remind everyone of the year-round water restrictions. Vegetable gardens are exempt from restrictions.

Zone #1 - Odd numbered houses and business:

6am-10am & 6pm-10pm ONLY on Tuesday, Thursday & Saturdays; Underground Irrigation 12am-4am

Zone #2 - Even numbered houses and businesses.

6am-10am & 6pm-10pm ONLY on Wednesday, Friday & Sunday; Underground Irrigation 12am-4am

THERE IS TO BE NO WATERING/SPRINKLING ON MONDAY

Anyone not following the restrictions will be subject to a first warning. If a second warning is issued, the water will be shut off and a \$75 fee will apply to have it turned back on.
