



2026 Taxes and Tolls

Ratepayers will notice that the 2026 Taxes will increase by 10%. Taxes are collected to pay for capital expenditures such as new distribution systems, equipment purchases, of the existing water system. This will help us fund future improvements to our aging infrastructure.

Tolls will not be increased. Tolls cover such things as electricity to pump water, water samples, lab analysis, staff wages, repairs, regular maintenance, government mandated audits, invoicing, postage, and insurance.

Water Quality

The District's drinking water comes from underground aquifers and is untreated. BFWD takes water samples from designated sites within the district and send them for regular testing of Total Coliform and E Coli. Any adverse results are reported directly by the laboratory to Interior Health as well as the BFWD. The testing results have shown that our water is good and within the requirements set out by the Canadian Drinking Water Quality Act.

If you are connecting, disconnecting your water line or installing irrigation systems, you **MUST** advise the Beaver Falls Waterworks as we will ensure our Certified Water Operator is present. This is for the safety of your drinking water.

Sprinkling Regulations (Bylaw No. 192)

Spring is here and the BFWD would like to remind every one of the **year-round** water restrictions.

Odd numbered houses and business:

6am-10am & 6pm-10pm ONLY on Tuesday, Thursday & Saturdays; Underground Irrigation 12am-4am

Even numbered houses and businesses.

6am-10am & 6pm-10pm ONLY on Wednesday, Friday & Sunday; Underground Irrigation 12am-4am

THERE IS TO BE NO WATERING/SPRINKLING ON MONDAY

Any one not following the restrictions will be subject to a first warning, if a second warning is issued water will be shut off and a \$75 fee will apply \$75 to have it turned back on. Bylaws can be found on our website.
